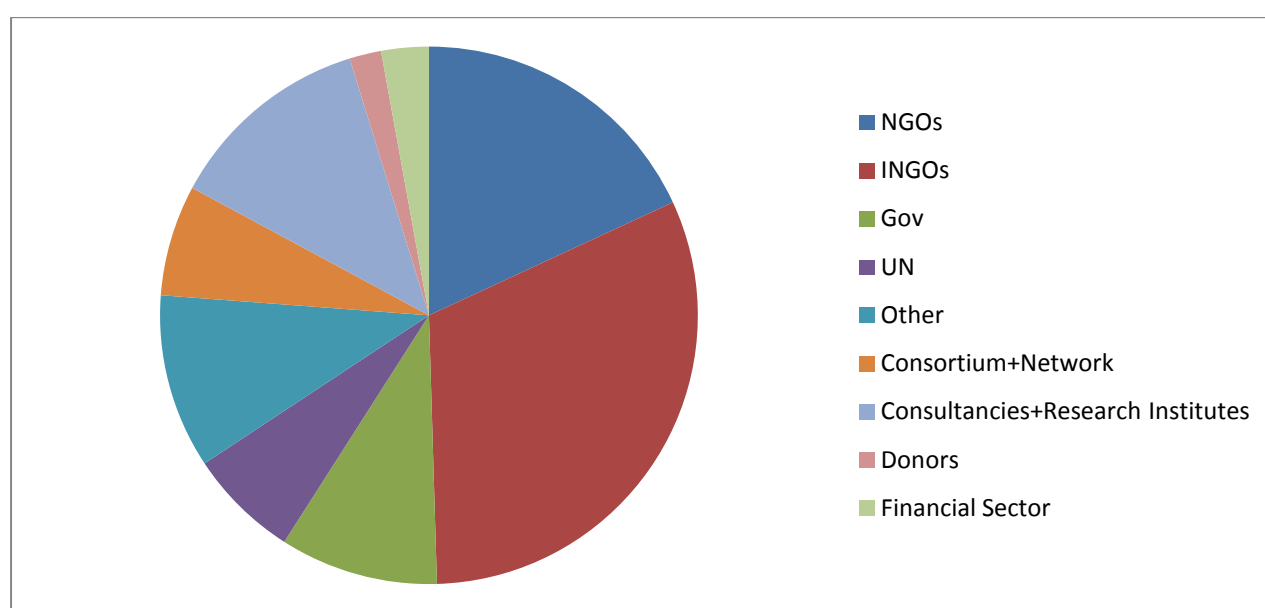


D-Group Information as of 06/07/15

The CaLP Discussion Groups (D-Groups) are a set of forums for global discussion of cash based responses and related work in emergencies.

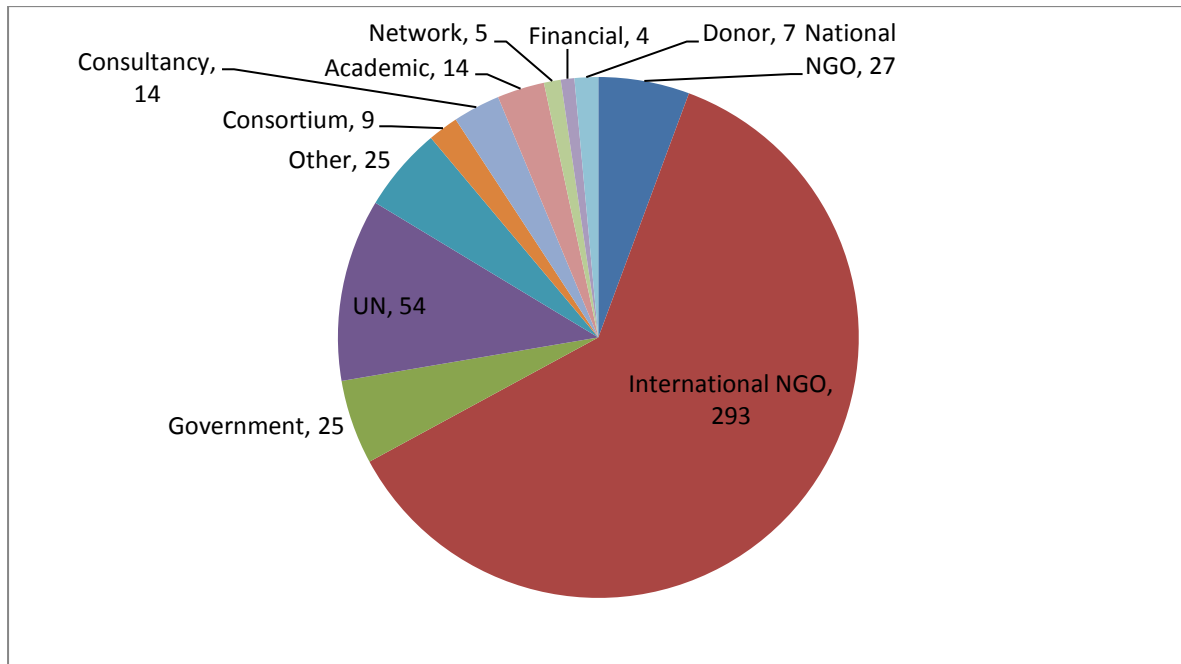
English Discussion Group

The CaLP English discussion group currently has 1270 members from 85 countries. These members also come from a diverse range of organisations, including NGOs, government bodies and UN agencies. The pie chart below shows the different types of organisations that are represented in the D-Group. *Please note that the figures below have been compiled through use of available data, and so while they give a general idea of D-Group composition, they do not provide a complete overview of membership.*

The number of members can be decomposed by their associated organisational type. As you can see from the pie chart below, INGOs make up the majority of the group, consisting of just under two thirds. The composition of the rest of the group is relatively diverse, with a large range of members from different types of organisations.
